

PROFILE OF SWPA POWER

And Its Impact On Missouri

Almost 1.8 million Missourians enjoy the benefits of clean, renewable and efficient hydropower generated at Corps of Engineers multipurpose reservoirs and marketed by the Southwestern Power Administration. SWPA power distributed to businesses and industry also supports **almost 169,000 jobs** in the state with a payroll of **more than \$3 billion annually**. SWPA also employs **52 Missourians** at its operations and maintenance center in **Springfield**.

The power marketed by SWPA is generated at 24 Corps projects in the region, including five in Missouri: Bull Shoals, Clarence Cannon, Harry S. Truman, Stockton and Table Rock. In 2001 these five dams generated **902 million kWh** of electricity, or more than 19 percent of the energy generated by SWPA's system. SWPA customers, through their electric rates, will repay 32 percent of the entire cost of constructing these five lakes — **more than \$456 million** — *plus interest!*
