

# PROFILE OF SWPA'S MUNICIPAL CUSTOMERS IN MISSOURI

- Fourteen municipally owned electric utilities in Arkansas are direct service customers of SWPA
  - ◆ Carthage Water and Electric Plant
  - ◆ City of Fulton
  - ◆ City of Hermann
  - ◆ City of Higginsville
  - ◆ City of Kennett
  - ◆ City of Lamar
  - ◆ Malden Board of Public Works
  - ◆ City of New Madrid
  - ◆ City of Nixa
  - ◆ City of Poplar Bluff
  - ◆ City of Sikeston
  - ◆ City Utilities of Springfield
  - ◆ City of Thayer
  - ◆ City of West Plains
- Another 27 Missouri cities and towns are served in full or part by electric cooperatives that receive Corps hydropower from SWPA
- The 14 cities with direct service contracts receive, on average, 27% of their total power needs from SWPA
  - ◆ These municipal utilities have contract rights to 197.7 MW of capacity from Corps hydropower projects
  - ◆ They provide power to more than 275,865 people and more than 18,198 commercial and industrial customers, including many regionally and nationally important manufacturers
  - ◆ The seven municipalities paid almost \$9.5 million for 724,238 MWh of energy purchased from SWPA in 1995
