

PROFILE OF SWPA POWER In The 6th Congressional District of Oklahoma

More than 170,000 constituents in the 6th Congressional District of Oklahoma enjoy the benefits of clean, renewable and efficient hydropower generated at Corps of Engineers multipurpose reservoirs and marketed by the Southwestern Power Administration in Tulsa. SWPA power distributed to businesses and industry also supports **more than 31,000 jobs** in the district with a payroll of **more than \$520 million annually**. SWPA also delivered 13 million kWh to **Vance Air Force Base** in 2001.

This power is generated at 24 Corps dams in the region, including eight in Oklahoma: Broken Bow, Denison (Lake Texoma), Eufaula, Ft. Gibson, Keystone, Robert S. Kerr, Tenkiller Ferry and Webbers Falls. In 2001 these eight dams generated **2.1 billion kWh** of electricity, or almost 46 percent of the energy generated by SWPA's system. SWPA customers, through their electric rates, will repay 34 percent of the entire cost of constructing these eight lakes — **almost \$234 million** — *plus interest!*
