

## PROFILE OF SWPA POWER In The 3rd Congressional District of Texas

**Almost 30,000 constituents** in the 3rd Congressional District of Texas enjoy the benefits of clean, renewable and efficient hydropower generated at Corps of Engineers multipurpose reservoirs and marketed by the Southwestern Power Administration.

The power marketed by SWPA is generated at 24 Corps dams in the region, including four in Texas: Denison Dam/Lake Texoma, Robert D. Willis/B.A. Steinhagen Lake, Sam Rayburn and Whitney. In 1995 these four dams generated **1,330 million kWh** of electricity, or more than 17 percent of the energy generated by SWPA's system. SWPA customers, through their electric rates, will repay 29 percent of the entire cost of constructing these four lakes — **more than \$78 million** — *plus interest!*

SWPA power is distributed in the district by the following consumer-owned, not-for-profit electric systems:

- **Denton County Electric Cooperative, Inc.**, Corinth
- **FEC Electric Cooperative, Inc.**, Greenville
- **Fannin County Electric Cooperative, Inc.**, Bonham

- **Rayburn Country Electric Cooperative**, Rockwall
